On the very first day of Sungi team arrival at Quetta, a meeting was arranged at Aurat Foundation office. Different organizations from Baluchistan participated in that meeting. Joint efforts were focused in that meeting and 1st assessment was done on the very same day at Ziarat. Mobile medical camp is in process by Sungi with the facilitation of AF and University of Baluchistan Quetta.

BNGOF Meeting:

A meeting was held at BNGOF camp office Quetta yesterday. It was shared that some villages in Pashin district like Khanozai, have also been damaged partially. It was discussed to pool resources at one place to make the process of distribution smooth and transparent. Regional Director TVO and community members were present too.

Coordination Meeting:

General Coordination Meeting was arranged at P&D Department Civil Secretariat Quetta. Chief Secretary Baluchistan chaired the meeting. Progress was shared by all the partners and issues were discussed.

Main points:

- i. Chief Secretary said that we have to work in 03 broad areas 1. Health 2. Shelter 3. Food.
- ii. WFP shared that they are going to support 30,000 people in 30 days.
- iii. In health sector Unicef, WHO and PDI shared that they have the budget of 5 million for the activities.
- iv. In Shelter CS shared that we have to provide i. Winterized Tents ii. CGI Sheets for transitional shelters
- v. ICRC Baluchistan shared that they have provided 3000 tents, 20,000 blankets and 2000 plastic sheets to affectees.
- vi. CS stressed to provide footwear, warm clothes, lanterns, kitchen items, latrines etc., on immediate basis.
- vii. BRSP Shared that 20 latrines have been provided by then in villages Ahmedoon and Tungi.
- viii. Participants agreed that organizations should work in 05 clusters 1. Shelter 2. Food and Nutrition 3. Agriculture 4. Wash-Sanitation 5. Health
- ix. CS advised organizations to ask their field officers deputed in the field to attend coordination meeting at DCO Ziarat Office. Contact person will be Mr. Javed Baloach from Social Welfare Department. Contact # is 0300-3887331, 0833-600138

- x. Sungi is conducting mobile medical camps in the affected area.
- xi. WFP will provide 02 Rub Halls for storage to food items and other accessories to Provincial Government of 1000 MT capacity.
- xii. Public Health Department shared that 06 filtration plants have been installed. 05 water tankers have been deputed there.
- xiii. A community member from Ahmedoon Mr. Naseer Kakar shared that distribution process is not satisfactory. There is no coordination between organization, army and government. He said that there are 800 houses there and each house has 03-04 families residing together. He demanded to provide at least 01 tent to each HH.
